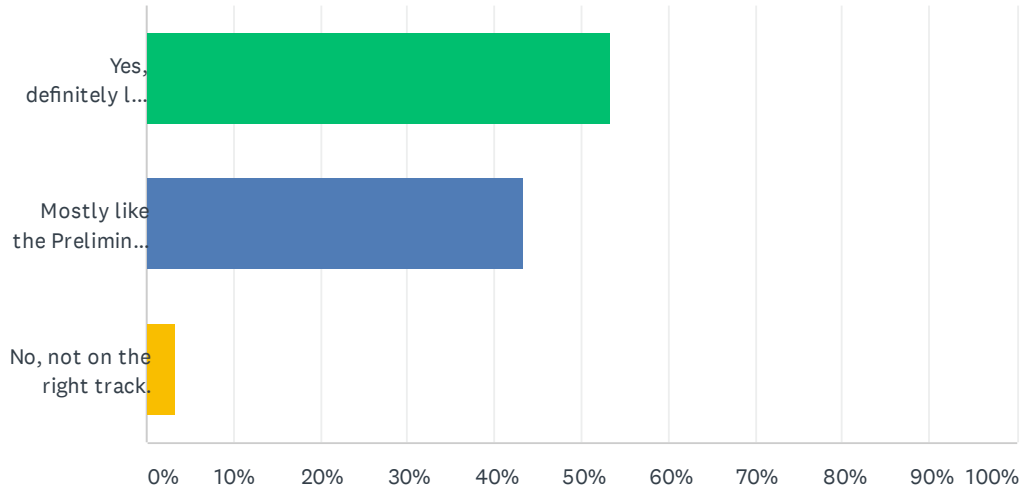


Q1 Overall, do you like the proposed park features and recommendations of the Preliminary Master Plan?
